home.

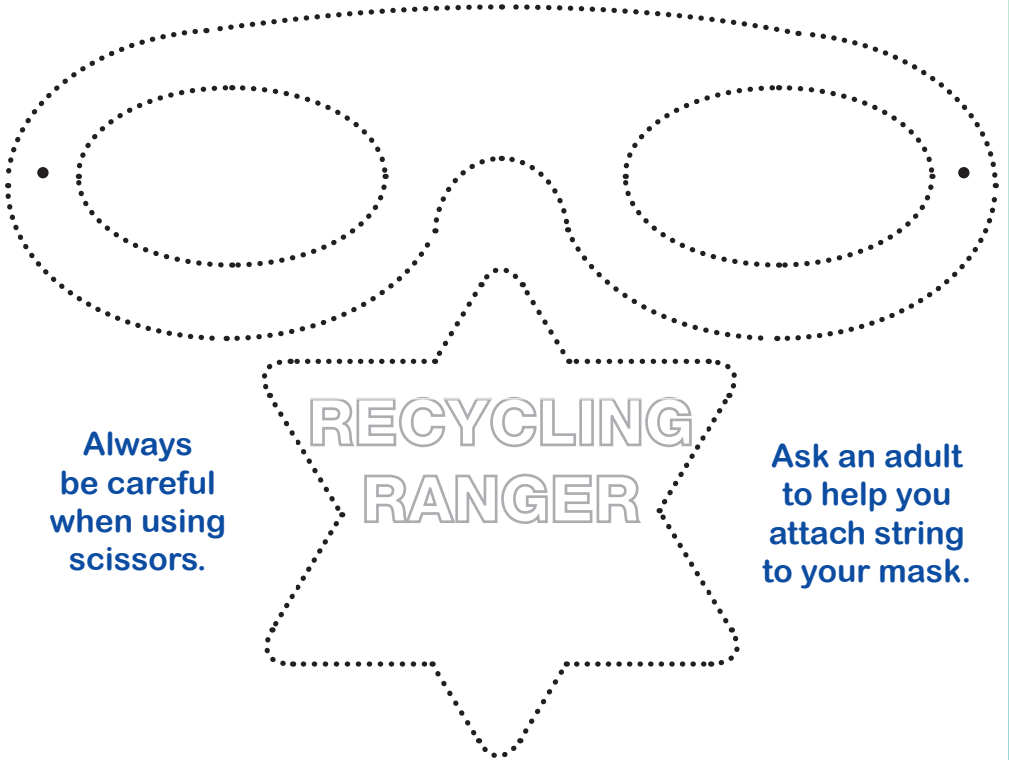
Why not colour-in your Ranger mask and badge,
