 STORYBOARDS

Please pick only one storyboard from the list.

Story 1 (Street litter)

- Dad gives his children £5 pocket money to take the rubbish bags to the bins
- Children run the rubbish bags to the bins excited as they're getting £5
- Children they are too lazy to open the bin lid so they throw the bin bags on the floor by the bins and run off
- Seagulls rip open the bags and litter goes all over the pavement causing a smelly mess
- SSE Superhero turns up, cleans up the mess
- SSE Superhero visits the children's dad and issues a £400 fine. The rubbish could cost dad £405

Story 2 (Fly-tipping)

- Family Pays a man £50 to take old kitchen away
- Man in van arrives and takes old kitchen away
- Man in van commits fly-tipping offence by dumping kitchen at the roadside
- SSE superhero arrives at the crime scene and finds families address on kitchen cupboard
- SSE superhero fines family £400 for fly-tipping
- SSE superhero gets man in vans details and he gets fined £400

Story 3 (Dog Fouling)

- Young woman walking her dog and her dog poops on the pavement
- Young woman picks the poo up in a bag and carries it with her
- Young woman spots her friends walking towards her and hangs the poo bag in a tree
- SSE superhero was walking behind her and watched everything
- SSE takes poo bag out of tree and hands it back to the woman in front of her friends along with a £100 fine
- Young woman's friends walk away looking back disgusted and young woman left crying

Please pick only one storyboard from the list.

Story 4 (Beach Litter)

- SSE superhero checks the beach to help keep it clean and tidy
- SSE superhero offers advice and rubbish bags to help groups to clean up after them
- One group ignores SSE and leaves litter on the beach
- The fish and birds start throwing litter back at the group
- A bird gets stuck in a bag
- SSE superhero fines each of the group £100 and tags them into #FFSDDL for fish sake don't drop litter' and saves the bird

Story 5 (Parks)


- A group of teenagers break bottles in the skate park thinking this is fun
- One of the teenagers siblings turns up with a skateboard to practice skateboarding
- Whoooosh The child falls and is seriously injured and the ambulance and SSE is called to the scene
- SSE Superhero speaks to the teenagers and visits their parents to warn them of fines and prosecution

Story 6 (Fast food outlets & Car Parks)

- Its raining so the gang go to hang out and skate at the bottom of the car park
- On the way they all go into the fast food shop and buy food and drink
- They sit, chat and eat and when finished eating drop and kick the empty wrappers all around the car park as they think this is fun
- SSE Superhero is watching the gang and arrives at the scene
- SSE Superhero gets the gang to clear their rubbish and then finds out where they live
- SSE Superhero makes a visit to each of the gangs homes and gives a formal warning
