

Existing Planning Policy


The Thanet Local Plan was adopted on 9 July 2020, and seeks to guide decisions on the town's development until 2031.





This engagement identified many of the people's perceptions, concerns, priorities, and vision for the town, which included:


- y employment opportunities for young people

This funding opened up projects that seek to address the identified concerns and priorities of Ramsgate's community.





Building upon the identified opportunities and challenges from the initial engagement, the plan suggests:


- → a distinguishing identity for Ramsgate tied to its heritage and maritime assets
- interventions, activities, and projects which guide the spending of the LUF and future investments





TDC, Historic England, Ramsgate Town Council & commercial letting agents were consulted about the challenges faced on the high street, and suggestions for improvement.


The result was this study which made recommendations to support the delivery of the High Street Heritage Action Zone (HSHAZ) project.



Stage 1 designs for all of the LUF projects were exhibited to the general public in the Royal Harbour. Over three hundred people attended to share their opinions. While most people continued to support the principles and aspirations of the LUF schemes, many had questions about how the schemes will be operated and how they will connect to the townscape around them.

Key Considerations for the Place Plan











□ The lack of job growth in Ramsgate is a key driver for LUF investment. How can we ensure that economic growth is sustainable and benefits everyone?






